FVC gains university-college status and becomes University College of the Fraser Valley (UCFV) in 1991. UCFV becomes the University of the Fraser Valley in 2008.

A fully accredited public university located in beautiful Abbotsford, British Columbia, the University of the Fraser Valley (UFV) is recognized internationally for teaching quality, student success, and an excellent learning environment.
